School Uniform Policy and Dress Code

STUDENT DRESS CODE

- Students' apparel should not distract from the educational environment therefore every student at Robert Morgan Educational Center is required to wear academy shirts specific to their academy.
- In addition to the mandatory uniform academy shirt requirement, Robert Morgan's Dress Code is as follows:
 - No flip-flops, backless sandals, homemade straps, bedroom slippers, metal cleats, or taps on shoes.
 - No tube tops, see-through blouses without camisoles or whole slips, bare backs, bare midriffs, sleeveless undershirts, "belly tees" or spaghetti straps.
 - No written messages, pictures, or symbols displayed which portray ideas that are offensive, or threaten the health, safety, or welfare of students and/or faculty (e.g., messages which relate to drugs, smoking, alcohol, sex, or profanity).
 - No visible display of undergarments (i.e., underpants or undershirts, etc.).
 - All dresses or skirts must be knee length.
 - No shorts or skorts.
 - No caps, hats, sweatbands, visors, bandanas, stocking caps / "do-rags", headscarves, or hair rollers.
 - No riding/cycling pants.
 - No beepers, cellular phones, Ipods, radios, cassette/CD players, or laser pointers are allowed during school hours. (If any of the above are brought to school and stolen from a student's possession, school administration is not responsible).
 - No electronic devices or games.
